■ Introduction

This document explains how to install and uninstall MELSOFT iQ Works (SW1DNC-IQWK-E□). Please read carefully before installing the product to your personal computer.

Installation

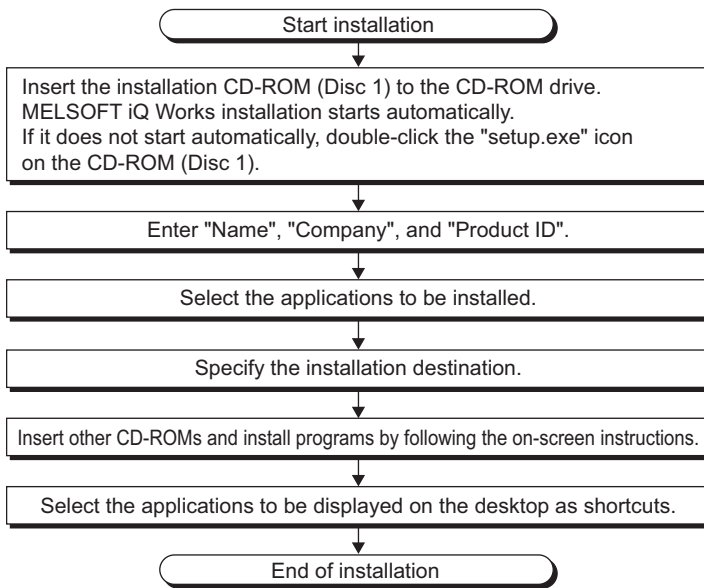
Install MELSOFT iQ Works or an application to the personal computer.

■ Confirm before installation

- Log on to the personal computer as a user having the "Administrator" (computer administration) privilege.
- Close all the applications running under Microsoft® Windows® Operating System before installation. If the product is installed while other applications are running, it may not operate normally.

■ Batch installation

Install multiple applications in batch.



■ Individual installation

Each application can be used individually by installing only the required application.

Double-click the "setup.exe" icon on each CD-ROM to install the application.

- *1 : When changing a CD-ROM, close Windows Explorer.
- *2 : Select MELSOFT Navigator only on the Selection of software dialog box.
- *3 : Select GT Designer3 only on the Selection of software dialog box.
- *4 : "setup.exe" is compressed. For the installation procedure, refer to GX Works2 Version 1 Operating Manual (Intelligent Function Module).

Point

- Product ID is written on the "License certificate" included with the product. Enter the 12-digit number divided into 3 and 9 digits.

■ FX series installation

When using special blocks or special units, installation of the related software is required. The related software of FX-ENET series may be downloaded from MELFANSweb.

For the method of obtaining the related software, contact the store where you purchased the product.

Precautions

- The driver install confirmation screen may appear during the software installation. When using Windows Vista® or Windows® 7, select "Install this driver software". When using Windows® XP, click the Continue anyway button.
- If the cancel button is clicked during the installation, the installation status becomes in the suspension process. In this case, insert the CD-ROM (Disc 1), and restart the installation by following the on-screen instructions.
- If a warning message from the security software is displayed, proceed the installation by following the on-screen instructions.
- The newer version software may be downloaded from MELFANSweb. After installing MELSOFT iQ Works, confirm the latest version on MELFANSweb. In order to download the newer version software, membership registration of FA-LAND on MELFANSweb is required.

Uninstallation

Uninstall MELSOFT iQ Works or an application from the personal computer.

1. In order to uninstall iQ Works, select "MELSOFT iQ Works" or an application in "Add or Remove Programs" from the control panel of Windows, and click the Remove button.

Recovering from incomplete installation

The installation may not be completed normally when the resident software such as a security software is being activated. In this case, disable the resident software temporarily and install the applications.

The following are the recovery instructions for when the screen is frozen during the installation.

■ Resident software can be disabled

1. Select "MELSOFT iQ Works - InstallShield Wizard" in Task Manager, and click the End Task button.
2. Restart the computer.
3. Disable the resident software such as a security software.
4. Insert the CD-ROM (Disc 1), and proceed the installation.
(☞ ■ Batch installation)

■ Resident software cannot be disabled

1. Select "MELSOFT iQ Works - InstallShield Wizard" in Task Manager, and click the End Task button.
2. Restart the computer.
3. Insert the CD-ROM (Disc 1), and proceed the installation.
4. Click the Cancel button on the Please insert next disc. dialog box.
5. Uninstall MELSOFT iQ Works.

6. Install each application separately.
